Four cottages can accommodate individuals or groups up to 22 people. Sheets, blankets, towels, solar lights, and charging facilities, hot showers, firewood and clean pit latrines provided. Self-catering or catering can be arranged.

## COMMUNITY MEETING HALL



Plan your next meeting at Twala Tenebo which hosts over 100 people: tables, chairs, a raised podium, pin boards, solar lighting, and charging. Women cater for all sizes of meeting supplying teas, lunches, and dinners.

Activities bring together the lives and knowledge of Maasai living in a dynamic and challenging landscape.

All proceeds go directly to the women and community to use for sustainable development and poverty reduction.

All guides are from the local area. Profits also go to supporting girl child education and poor elderly people.

We hope you will enjoy yourself while helping our community and improving our natural environment.

Twala Tenebo is near the little village of Il Polei just 60 km from Nanyuki on tarmac until the last 30 km of all-weather road.

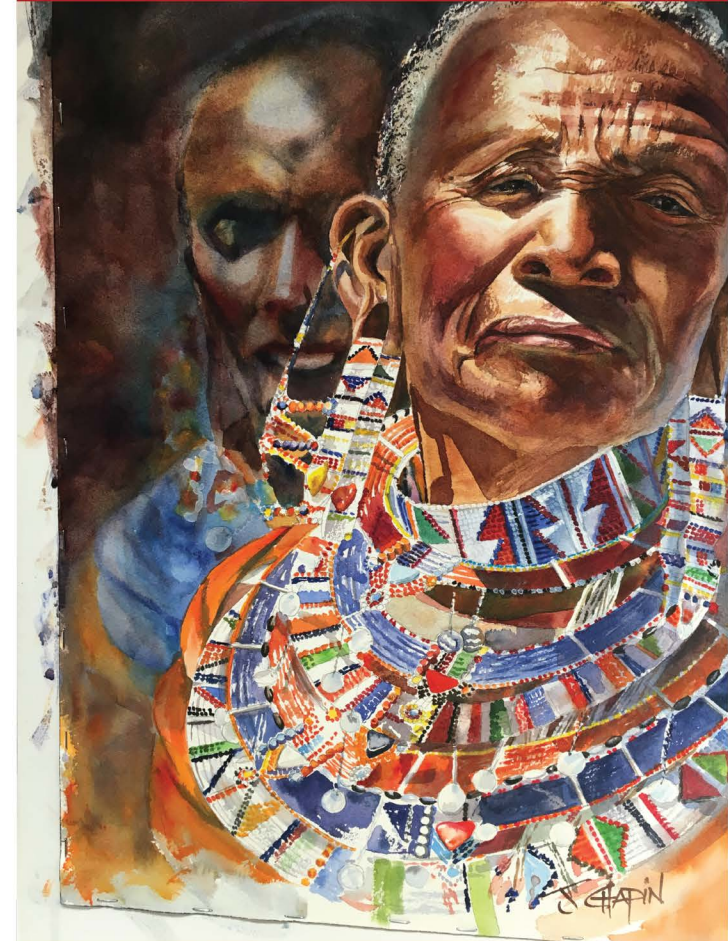
You can reach us by matatu, taxi, or saloon car. 4WD not necessary.

# MANYATTA ACTIVITY HIGHLIGHTS

Unwind and Relax while Experiencing Nature, Wildlife and Maasai Culture in a Unique way. Walk with Wild Baboons. Learn Medicinal uses of Wild Plants and how the Landscape has changed.

### CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

Listen to Maasai songs and exchange experiences with the women. Learn beading, hut-building and try your hand at carrying water. See men make fire, play bao, fashion arrows. Have a goat roast with songs and stories around the campfire.



### WALKING WITH BABOONS

Take a guided walk among a troop of wild baboons and learn about these amazing primates close-up. By contrast to other primates, a baboon group is filled with active and smart monkeys who practice sophisticated politics in their daily lives. What happens when smart baboons meet their smart human cousins? Truly a unique and exciting experience.



### MEDICINAL PLANT WALK

Maasai traditional medicine has been extremely effective in treating symptoms and diseases. Names and uses of a variety of medicinal plants and how they are used for people and livestock.



### BIO - ENTERPRISES

Women are trying new ways to generate income and are very concerned about conserving the natural resources around them. New bio-enterprises include: cultivating aloe plants for soap, lotions and cosmetics, bee-keeping for honey, a kitchen garden practicing permaculture.
